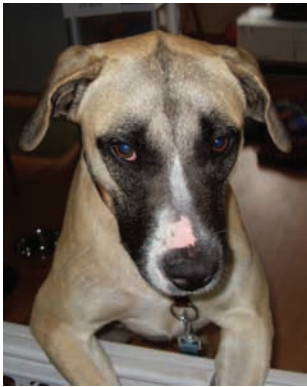

River, a four year-old female Labrador/Boxer spent a total of **208** days under the care of the PEI Humane Society before finding her "fur"ever home.



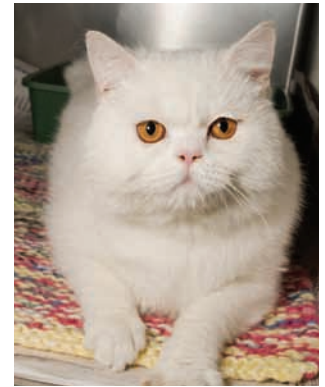
MIRABELLE

Additional staff has "paw" sitive affect on Society's growing needs

The PEI Humane Society is proud that its staff now includes a Registered Veterinarian Technician as its Shelter Manager as well as a part-time Shelter Veterinarian.

Their medical skills and training provide an enhanced level of care for the animals at the shelter.

In fact, the PEI Humane Society is one of the only shelters in the Maritimes to have these professionals on-staff.

In addition, a third Animal Protection Officer was hired this year to help respond to cruelty investigations and/or By-law enforcement concerns.

Cat Condo and Dog Adoption areas receive much-needed renovations

The purpose of renovating the outdoor cat condo was not to provide additional space for felines, but to provide communal living and fresh air to help lower stress that shelter life can cause.
